Keystone Simulation and Education Center (KSEC) is a non-profit simulation education center located at 612 Frankfort Road, Potter Township, Monaca, PA 15061. KSEC is a 24,000 square foot facility consisting of 10 rooms of high-tech simulation scenario training. The simulation rooms include an Emergency room with ambulance, Obstetrics and Gynecology suite, birthing suite, neo-natal and pediatric, Intensive Care Unit, Medical Surgical, Family Practice, Home Health Care and Task Training Rooms, as well as a simulated pharmacy and blood bank.

As a free-standing simulation center, KSEC allows for neutrality and non-affiliation with any one institution enabling us to serve the needs of ALL healthcare and educational institutions in the region. KSEC brings state of the art simulation technology to those with budgets that do not permit in-house upgrading and maintenance of simulation equipment.

Each classroom is equipped with a computerized digital video recorder whose playback is sent to a debriefing room. There are three classrooms in the facility that can accommodate up to 105 students. Each room is equipped with integrated video capable of viewing either the same presentation simultaneously and the capability to show varied presentations consecutively.

Our facility can accommodate small to large groups with meeting space. In addition, complete banquet services including, continental breakfast, complete table service dining and refreshments for breaks. Conveniently located off Interstate 376, KSEC is just 40 minutes from downtown Pittsburgh, PA.

KSEC provides free to all participants parking, wireless internet and breakout rooms.
